- Ensure parent questions are understood
- Ask for clarification
- Expect and establish mutual respect

Data privacy laws (i.e. Family Educational Rights and Protection Act - FERPA) protect the rights of students with disabilities. School personnel are able to share coach contact information with parents, but parents are required to contact coaches directly, which protects your family, school and the coach in the area of data privacy. With the right to have others' personal information comes the responsibility to retain the confidentiality outside the IEP team.
