 Superintendent McNulty discussed two NLSEC Physical Therapists on a Barnum contract, how they're shared among the NLSEC, and working to settle that contract. Barnum teachers are also not settled and so the district will work to settle that first with the PT contracts to follow.

Fiscal:

 Working budget was compared to the planning budget with a difference of \$1,446.85

Directors Report: (Attachment E)

- Celebrations Marigold Effect Great gardeners know companion planting. Marigolds in our schools are people who are positive and strong vs. walnut trees who are negative individuals.
- Federal Determination: MN "Meets Requirements" Every state has to report on various indicators. MN is in its 5th year as one of three states "meeting" the requirements for both Part B and C. Coordinators are working to review Progress Reporting to gain baseline data.
- Sp Ed Finance Updates Increase of 2% on the general formula. Budget of \$90 million to prevent cross subsidy. State Sp. Ed. Cap phased out in 19-20. Open enrollment services cost for the serving district is increasing.
- Northern Lights Interagency: Parent Advisory Committee meets five times per year and all parents of students with disabilities are invited to attend. This sub-committee is where parents are invited to discuss different topics from a parent standpoint-required to have 50% of members as parents. Districts are encouraged to advertise this group via posters, link on their website, etc... The Nov. interagency council meeting will be combined with Duluth's at the PACC.
- Dyslexia Screening and LETRS Professional Development Dyslexia is a specific learning disability in reading. Districts are required to screen for dyslexia and have a plan to help students get to grade level in reading. A LETRS Professional Development (recommended by MDE) cohort is being offered to district teachers all year long by Ms. Hagen as the facilitator. Ms. Hagen will send a one minute info video to all Superintendents.
