Educational Records includes information that is directly related to a student kept in any recorded manner - including special education. Personally Identifiable Information is information that is directly linkable that could be harmful if fallen into wrong hands (SSN, family, etc)

Contact from county agency, attorney, etc.

Do Not Respond.

Inform Case Manager

Protect your own boundaries. Be wary of handing out your personal cell phone number, and discussing student information with parents.

Information regarding students and programming should be shared by the teacher.

Pay attention to cell phone use, social media, emails, conversations with family and friends.

Preserve the rights of students by being aware of surroundings and visitors.

Be aware of "link-ability".

Vulnerability

Vulnerability is defined as open to injury or attack.

How could a student identified as DCD be vulnerable?

How could a student identified as SLD be vulnerable?

Vulnerability

Be aware of physical, social, academic, and communicative vulnerability.

Make sure students' voices are heard and rights upheld.

Vulnerability

Developing, practicing, and securing *self advocacy skills* is an effective strategy to overcome vulnerability.
