U.S. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -- NCES 2011-018

Among institutions that enrolled students with disabilities during the 2008–09 academic year,

- 93% provided additional exam time
- 77% provided classroom notetakers
- 72% faculty-provided written course notes or assignments
- 72% help with learning strategies or study skills
- 71% alternative exam formats
- 70% adaptive equipment and technology

Summary

Accommodations provided in high school differ substantially from those provided in college. College level accommodations are directed by the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act which mandates **accessing the right to use** accommodations (access does not mean advantage). High School accommodations are directed by the Individuals With Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) that applies to primary and secondary high schools and mandates **success with entitlement to accommodations**.
